

# POETRY TERMS!



Jack Kerouac and Allen Ginsberg were part of the \_\_\_ Generation  
 The *Iliad*, *Odyssey*, & *The Song of Hiawatha* are this type of poem  
 \_\_\_ verse consists of unrhymed lines all of the same meter  
 An elegy is a poem that laments the \_\_\_ of someone or something  
 Orange is one of the few words that does not \_\_\_ with anything  
 A \_\_\_ tells a story or legend, is often about love, and can be sung  
 "She's like the wind" is an example of this figure of speech  
 This type of poem has fourteen lines and a specific rhyme scheme  
 A group of lines with the same rhyme scheme and meter is a \_\_\_  
 A \_\_\_ is a pair of lines that rhyme and are of similar length  
 A sometimes humorous inscription on a tomb is called an \_\_\_  
 John Keats wrote *Ode to a \_\_\_ Urn*  
 A grouping of lines that repeats throughout a poem is called a \_\_\_  
 An \_\_\_ poem the first letter of each line spells out a word or phrase  
 A \_\_\_ is usually humorous, but is considered of little literary worth  
 A humorous and often bawdy poem that consists of five lines  
 "All the world is a stage" is an example of this figure of speech  
 Confessionalist poets use \_\_\_ experiences as their inspiration  
 In a \_\_\_ there are four lines, and lines 2 and 4 must rhyme  
 Shelley, Blake, Wordsworth, and Byron are considered \_\_\_ poets  
 \_\_\_ poems can rhyme or not, and often have no set meter  
 \_\_\_ poems tell a story and include ballads, lays, and epics  
 Haiku poems have a total of \_\_\_ syllables
